### • Conference Recap

- Sports ETA
  - Evan recently went to meet with sports events producers and had scheduled 1:1 meetings to discuss bringing more tournaments to Santa Clarita
  - Highlights:
    - USA Flag Football first weekend in March 2024, has held event here 2xs in the past and now wants to do a multi-year, add youth component, with 60-80 teams playing over a couple of days
    - Other promising conversations with Quadball and US Australian Rules Football
- **IPW** largest inbound travel trade show. Our fourth year going to this conference and we had over 60 scheduled 1:1 meetings with international media and tour operators.

- April hosted media from Brazil Luciano Palumbo (Turismo Etc.). He used Santa Clarita as a jumping off point – stayed here but drove to other spots like LA or Ventura and did a month-long road trip.
  - We're on their radar! Brought in good buzz from the Brazilian media and companies we met with and tour operators.
- Will provide contacts to the hotels for the bed banks and tour operators that want to work directly with our local hotels lots of follow-up to do as they'll reach out
- Next year's conference will be in Los Angeles so we're looking to go big FAM tours for media and tour operators.
  - Over 6,000 buyers at last conference, next year's most likely more since in California
