
<u>Sugar Daddy Marathon</u> – Celebrate Dad with a family-friendly fun run over Father's Day weekend.

SANTA CLARITA BACKGROUND/FACTS

- Six Flags Magic Mountain and Hurricane Harbor are our biggest attractions, but there are many other reasons people come to Santa Clarita.
- Santa Clarita is the third largest City in Los Angeles County with a population over 250,000 if you count both inside City limits (225,000+) and the surrounding area.
- Over 10 hotels with almost 1,900 rooms to offer.
- Northern most city in Los Angeles County. Many people use Santa Clarita as a gateway to Los Angeles because we are close to many attractions:
- We are about 20 minutes away from Universal Studios and Warner Brothers Studios and less than an hour from Ventura, which is our closest beach. It's common for travelers to stay in Santa Clarita for a few nights – go to Six Flags one day, Universal Studios the next day and Ventura Beach the day after that which is reached via a picturesque road trip through <u>Heritage Valley</u> via Highway 126.
- There are many advantages to staying in Santa Clarita: it's close to Hollywood, Burbank and about 30 miles from Downtown Los Angeles, but since it's on the edge of Los Angeles, the hotels are a much greater value than staying in Hollywood, beach communities or Los Angeles. Santa Clarita is much more "breathable" than LA and it is easy to navigate.
- Santa Clarita has a rural charm in its <u>Old Town Newhall District</u> and high-end dining, shopping and entertainment at the <u>Westfield Valencia Town Center</u> which is right across the street from our largest hotel, the <u>Hyatt Regency Valencia</u>.
- Santa Clarita is home to many world class events. We have hosted the <u>Amgen Tour of California</u> 14 times, which is more than any other City. As you may know the cycling race is produced by ASO, who also operates the Tour de France.
- Santa Clarita also hosts an Oktoberfest, the Spartan Race, Boots & Brews, <u>Santa Clarita Marathon</u>, the <u>Santa Clarita Cowboy Festival</u> and many other events throughout the year.
- Santa Clarita is home to wineries, a multitude of wine tasting rooms, breweries and gastropubs.
- Santa Clarita has a rich history and was where gold was first discovered in California.
- Santa Clarita has grown over the years, but was home to thousands of western films and television shows. Santa Clarita is still one of the most filmed cities in California and is/was home base to shows like Westworld, Once Upon a Time in Hollywood, NCIS, SWAT and <u>many others.</u> Santa Clarita is home to tens of thousands of acres of open space and is great for outdoor adventure. <u>Vasquez Rocks</u> is a short drive and is recognizable in many films and television shows including Westworld, most Star Treks, Austin Powers, the Flintstones and Austin Powers. Also Santa Clarita is a great stop on a road trip for international travelers, many of which plan to visit Los Angeles, San Fransico and Las Vegas.
- Since Santa Clarita is in northern Los Angeles it's the first big city in the Los Angeles area travelers pass coming south from San Francisco which is about 5 hours away. Las Vegas is about a four-hour drive and San Diego is typically 2-3 hours (about 165 miles).
