 - For the first month, until the end of our fiscal year on June 30, there will only be **one** trolley running we will not have printed brochures for you to give out at that time
- O Beginning July 1st, an additional route to Old Town Newhall, including Hotel Lexen, will begin. In addition to getting people to Six Flags, this gives hotel guests on the north side of town a way to get to Valencia Town Center to shop and eat and also, they can transfer at the Town Center/Hyatt stop to get to Old Town Newhall for additional shopping, eating, and theater experiences
