
MANDATORY ORGANICS LEGISLATION

California passed a law, Senate Bill 1383, with a goal to improve air quality by reducing greenhouse gas emissions from organic waste, including food waste and landscape waste, that is disposed at landfills. This law requires businesses and multi-family complexes to recycle their food waste and landscape waste. It will also require edible food generating businesses such as grocery stores, food service distributors, supermarkets and restaurants to provide the edible food (that would otherwise be disposed) to organizations that will redistribute it. The State requires that applicable business generators:

- Separate organic waste from other waste and participate in a collection and recycling service for organics, or:
- · Recycle its organic waste on site, and/or self-haul its organic waste off-site for recycling, and/or:
- Donate edible food waste to an eligible food rescue organization.

Holiday Schedule


Burrtec Waste observes the following holidays:

COMMERCIAL GARBAGE SERVICE

Burrtec provides waste collection services to all commercial, industrial and multi-family properties in the City of Santa Clarita. If you would like to review your business's waste and recycling programs, please contact our office at (661) 222-2249 to receive a free waste assessment.

Bin Services

Sizes ranging from 1.5 cubic yards to 6 cubic yards Compactor bins in 3 or 4 cubic yards

Roll-off Services

10 Cubic yard demolition or roofing boxes 20, 30, and 40 cubic yard debris boxes 40 cubic yard compactors

Temporary Bins

3 cubic yards for special clean-up projects

Locking bins (garbage or recycling) Extra pick-ups Bulky item collection



ORGANICS RECYCLING

Recycling of organics, such as landscape waste and food waste, is mandatory for businesses in accordance with California Senate Bill 1383 (SB 1383). Landscape waste and food waste must be handled and stored separately from garbage and other recyclables to avoid contamination. All businesses, including multi-family complexes, are required to separate food waste and landscape waste from garbage and other recyclables and arrange for organics recycling.

Landscape Waste

Landscape waste/green waste services are available to all commercial customers in the City of Santa Clarita and should be placed loosely in the organics cart or bin.

Acceptable Landscape Waste

- Grass clippings
- Brush & shrub trimmings
- Tree trimmings
- Twigs & small branches
- Weeds & leaves

Non-acceptable Landscape Waste

- Dirt & rock
- Plastic bags Palm fronds
- Concrete Cactus
- Bird of Paradise plants

Food Waste

A variety of food waste collection service levels are available to commercial and industrial customers in the City of Santa Clarita. Food waste should be placed in bags.



Acceptable Food Waste

- Dairy products
- Cooked meat
- Fruits & vegetables
- Cooked seafood
- Coffee grounds
- Poultry
- Breads and grains
- Food soiled paper products

Non-acceptable Materials

- Plastic products
- Styrofoam
- Glass products
- Non-biodegradable materials
- Metal products

MIXED RECYCLING

One outstanding feature of Burrtec's commitment to the City of Santa Clarita is recycling collection at no additional charge. Our recycling team is eager to help implement successful recycling programs that are customized to suit the needs of your business. A specialist will visit your business to gain an understanding of operations and to identify any items for recycling. After the site visit, a program is designed to help reduce costs and increase recycling.

California Assembly Bill 341 (AB341) includes a mandatory commercial recycling component in the effort to save landfill space and reduce greenhouse gas emissions. All businesses with four or more yards of collection service (per week) will be required to establish and maintain recycling service.

DO NOT mix garbage or hazardous waste with recyclable materials. Contaminated materials can often prevent recyclables from being recycled properly. Please recycle responsibly.
